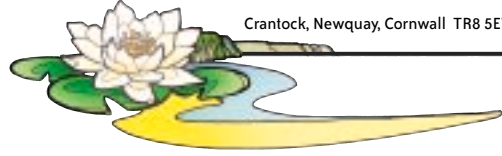

Directions

Go through the Kissing Gate at the bottom of A field between caravans 19 and 20, head for the bottom left hand corner of the field where you will find white markers on the trees and posts. Follow these until the last stile, then cross the stream. This is Penpol Creek, continue along the creek for approx 200 yards, when the creek opens out to a large sandy area. You are now on the bed of the River Gannel, turn left and follow the river downstream to Crantock Beach.

NOTE OF WARNING.

The River Gannel is a tidal river, at high tide the water comes up to the start of Penpol Creek. Before attempting a walk to Crantock Beach CHECK THE TIDE TIMES DISPLAYED ON THE NOTICE BOARD AT THE START OF THE WALK.

SAFETY ADVICE FOR POOL USERS

Safety advice for pool users.

These facilities are provided for the enjoyment of guests, however to ensure the safety of the users it is necessary to apply certain standards and restrictions, these are based on guidance issued by the Health and Safety Executive and Sport England. We therefore ask for your co-operation in complying with these requirements which will be enforced by the management of Trevella Caravan and Camping Park to ensure safety standards are maintained to a high level.

Please read the swimming pool safety code.

The large pool has a minimum water depth of 0.81 metres and slopes to a maximum depth of 1.22 metres at the opposite end. The paddling pool is 30 centimetres deep.

Water quality and depth are checked daily.

Children under the age of 15 are not permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by a responsible adult. Please do not be tempted to allow your children to use the pool on their own. The pool area is under CCTV surveillance and they will be asked to leave the pool area.

Diving, bombing, jumping, running and ducking are not permitted. The pool is not sufficiently deep and serious injury may occur.

Drinking glasses and glass bottles must not be taken into the pool area, broken glass can cause serious injuries and the pool to be closed until a thorough check has been carried out.

Please place all rubbish and litter in the bins provided.

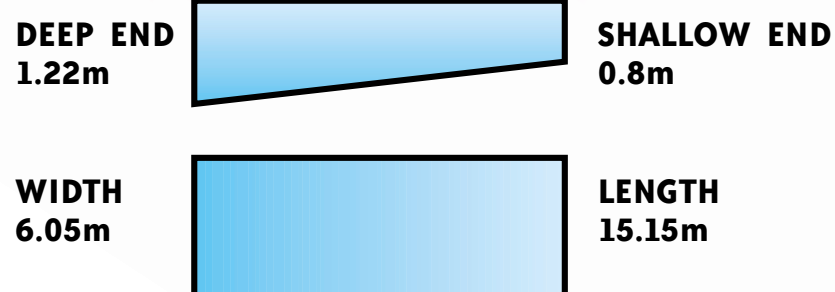
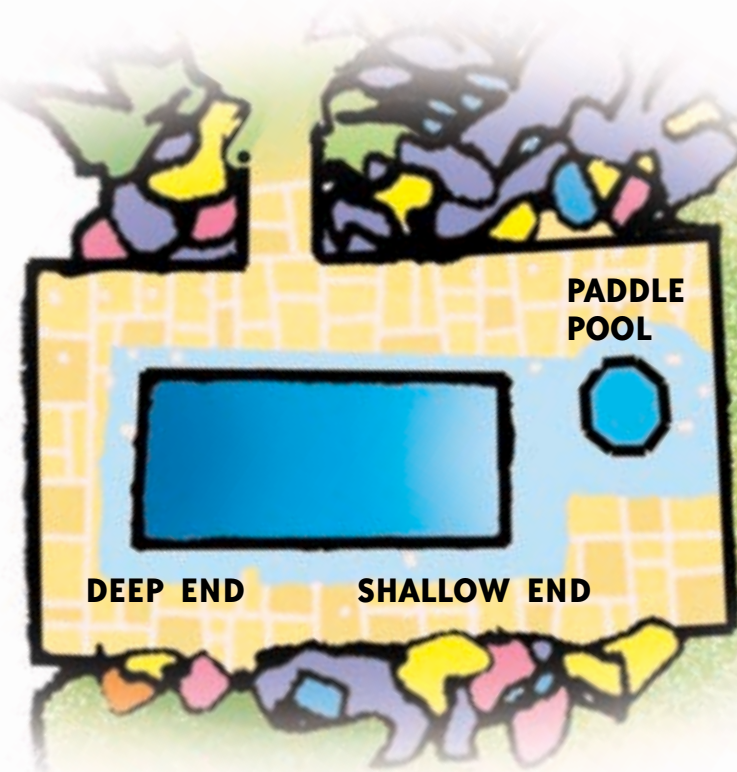
Inflatables are not allowed in the pool area.

No alcohol. No Surfboards. No lone bathing.

EMERGENCY ACTION

If you observe someone in difficulties or an accident or incident occurs, immediately operate the alarm to summon assistance.

An emergency alarm is situated by the entrance gate and another is opposite the entrance gate.

The rescue equipment provided may be used to support or pull the person from the water.

SWIMMING POOL SAFETY CODE

**The swimming pool is open from 8.30am to 7pm daily.
The swimming pool is not supervised.**

Please take note of the following information.

Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

Spot the dangers.

Swimming pools can be hazardous.
Water presents a risk of drowning.
Injuries can occur from hitting the hard surrounds.
Never misuse equipment.

Always swim within your ability.

Never swim after a big meal or consumption of alcohol.
Avoid holding your breath and swimming long distances under water.
Take care if you have any medical conditions such as asthma, diabetes or heart problems.

Take safety advice.

Avoid unruly behaviour.
No ducking others or acrobatics.
No shouting or screaming as this may distract from a real emergency.
Foolish behaviour could cost lives.

Look out for yourself and other swimmers.

It is safer to swim with a companion. Keep an eye open for others, especially younger children, unconfident and non-swimmers.

Learn how to help.

If you see someone in difficulty, call for assistance immediately.
In an emergency keep calm and do exactly as you are instructed.
